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Workshop Overview

Recent conversations on leadership and organizational upgrade placed strong emphasis on values and ethics, which is otherwise known as Values-Based Leadership. This discussion relates to intra-organisational leadership benefits, challenges and integration of values. With the demand for greater transparency and Values-based leadership (VBL), corporate boards encounter more complex challenges in their oversight functions. Whether the issue is financial and risk management, corporate strategy, executive compensation, reputation protection or regulatory compliance, the responsibilities of the board and its committees as well as the individual directors (Chairmen, Executive and Non-Executive or Independent directors) remain enormous and quite demanding. Furthermore, with the development in technology and ability to track activities, chances of crystallisation of their liabilities increase. The

programme is designed to provide deep insights into the roles and responsibilities, strategies and interactions required by boards and individual directors to overcome challenges and become highly effective and efficient systems with legitimate leadership practices.

Most codes of best and leading practices in Corporate Governance require directors to undergo periodic refresher leadership training as designed to enable them share values, knowledge and enhance skills to become better leaders and change agents, participating in boards with the attendant qualities of enhancing their organisations' competitiveness and sustainability.

Objectives

At the end of the training participants will be able to:

- Discuss the concept of corporate governance and values-based leadership as well as how these concepts can be turned into productive practices that add value to their organisations.
- Build strategic skills for effective leadership decision making, strategic development and implementation.
- Define roles, responsibilities and liabilities of the board and how directors can work more effectively together to maximise the board's contribution to company's success, while avoiding legal minefields.
- Analyse the board on which they sit, identifying shortfalls from best practice, act as change agent and implement changes necessary to make their boards more robust and effective.
- Formulate a holistic approach to identifying leadership challenges, providing solutions and adapting to change.
